

Kingston is situated between Montreal, Ottawa and Toronto and is easily accessible by plane, car or train. Flight service to Kingston from Toronto and Montreal begins September 12 and can be booked through Air Transat and Air Canada through Expedia.



Travel from Toronto

There are 2 airports in Toronto – Pearson and Billy Bishop

Train

From Pearson: The Union Pearson (UP) Express train travels regularly from Toronto's Pearson Airport to downtown Toronto. The line ends at Union Station where you can follow the signs to Via Rail trains and catch a train to Kingston.

If you arrive at the Billy Bishop airport in downtown Toronto, you can take a free ferry ride to the mainland terminal and then hop on a free shuttle to Toronto Union Station.

Car

Toronto is about a 3 hour drive from Kingston along Highway 401.

Air

You can fly directly from Toronto's Billy Bishop airport to Kingston using FLYGTA.

Travel from Ottawa

Train

From the Ottawa-MacDonald airport, you can take a 20-minute taxi ride to the Ottawa train station and take a Via Rail train to Kingston.

Car

Ottawa is about 2 hours away from Kingston by Car. All major rental car companies are available at the airport.

Travel from Montreal

Train

From Trudeau Airport you can take a free shuttle to Dorval train station when you can take a Via Rail train ride to Kingston.

Car

Montreal is about a 3 hour car ride to Kingston. All major rental cars are available and it is an easy drive up Hwy 401 to Kingston.

Air

You can fly directly from Montreal's Trudeau airport to Kingston using Pascan Aviation.
